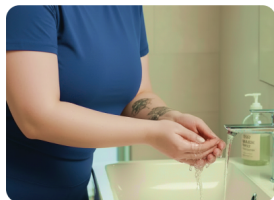


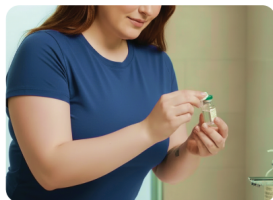

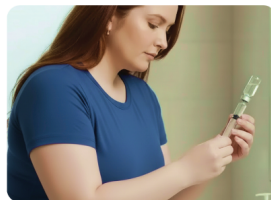
## Gather supplies

Gather your vial, syringe and alcohol swabs, and wash your hands thoroughly.



## Prepare your vial

Remove the cap and wipe the top of the vial with an alcohol swab.



## Prepare your dose

Pull plunger from the syringe to draw air equal to your dose. Pierce vial with the syringe and push the air in, then draw the correct dose of medication.



## Give the injection

Wipe skin with an alcohol swab, and insert the needle into your belly, thigh, or the back of your upper arm and press down the plunger.



## Dispose safely

Leave used syringe uncapped, and place in a sharps container. Never throw in the trash.



## Aftercare

Minor bruising or bleeding can occur. Press gently with cotton-don't rub.

## Reading Your Dose

Your syringe is marked in units (U), numbered by 10s up to 100. Check your medication label for the exact units to draw—this may be written as 'units' or 'U' on your label. Pull the plunger back to the number on the syringe and you're all set.
